Muskegon County Garden Club, Inc is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation organized in 1932, and a member of Michigan Garden Clubs, Inc (District IV), and National Garden Clubs, Inc (Central Region). Our objectives are to aid in the protection of native trees, plants, and birds; to stimulate the love and knowledge of nature among amateurs; to encourage home gardening and promote civic beautification; and to aid one another in garden planting.

Meetings are generally held on the third Tuesday of the month at 11:30AM and include social time, lunch, and a speaker or special presentation. No meeting is called in January. Annual dues are \$25. Ongoing activities include a biennial Standard Flower Show and a biennial Garden Walk held in alternate years, Neighborhood Garden Recognition, Garden Therapy at Seminole Shores, and regular maintenance of the raised bed gardens in front of Muskegon's Historic Railroad Depot/ Tourist Info Center. In past years we have installed 2 Blue Star Memorial Markers and are planning the installation and dedication of one more. Members are also encouraged to take advantage of the educational opportunities provided through Michigan Garden Clubs, Inc and National Garden Clubs, Inc.
